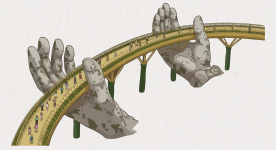

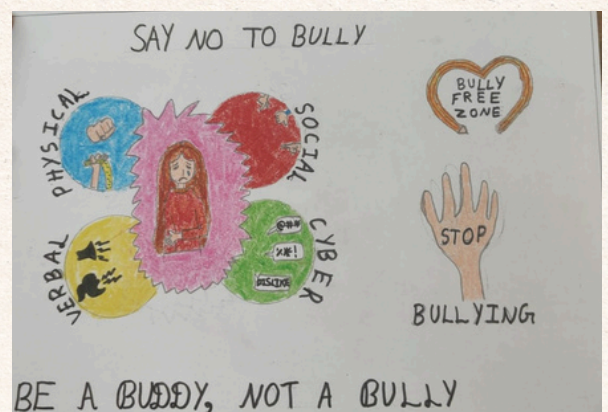


Young Voices In Heavenly Tunes"

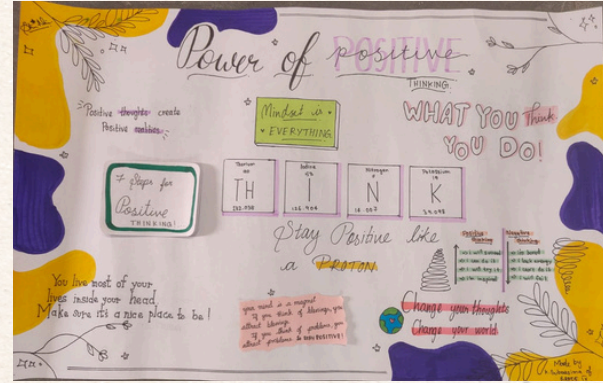
First Prize in Silambam Competition

After the inspiring speeches, the Chief Guest officially declared **TECHNOVANZA 2026 open**, marking the beginning of the competitions.

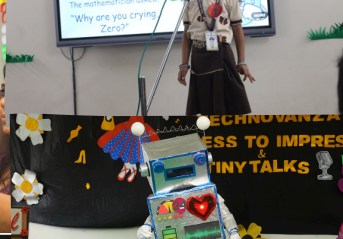


TINY TALKS
